A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOBILE ELECTRONIC DEVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-137, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 3 "(e) As used in this section:
- 4 "Emergency responders" includes firefighters, emergency
- 5 medical technicians, mobile intensive care technicians,
- 6 emergency management workers, police officers, and federal and
- 7 state law enforcement officers.
- 8 "Fleet vehicle" means any vehicle validly registered
- 9 pursuant to section 286-53.5.
- "Mobile electronic device" means any handheld or other
- 11 portable electronic equipment capable of providing wireless or
- 12 data communication between two or more persons or of providing
- 13 amusement, including but not limited to a cellular phone, text
- 14 messaging device, paging device, personal digital assistant,
- 15 laptop computer, video game, or digital photographic device, but
- 16 does not include any audio equipment, including handheld or
- 17 other portable electronic equipment used solely for the purpose

- 1 of electronically streaming music or other audio broadcasts, or
- 2 any equipment installed in a motor vehicle for the purpose of
- 3 providing navigation, emergency assistance to the operator of
- 4 the motor vehicle, or video entertainment to the passengers in
- 5 the rear seats of the motor vehicle.
- 6 "Operate" a motor vehicle means to drive or assume actual
- 7 physical control of the vehicle upon a public way, street, road,
- 8 or highway, including operation while temporarily stationary
- 9 because of traffic, a traffic light, or a stop sign.
- "Use" or "using" means holding a mobile electronic device
- 11 while operating a motor vehicle [→]; provided that "use" or
- 12 "using" shall not include holding a mobile electronic device
- 13 that is being used for the sole purpose of electronically
- 14 streaming music or other audio broadcasts transmitted through a
- 15 wireless or data connection."
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 17 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 18 begun before its effective date.
- 19 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
