A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AERONAUTICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes the need to correct 2 the penalty for safety practices and licensing of individuals 3 engaged in commercial activities at public airports by amending 4 the provisions relating to penalties under chapter 261, Hawaii 5 Revised Statutes, to allow for either a criminal penalty or a 6 fine for the behavior and activities that do not threaten the 7 safety or operation of aircraft but violate the provisions of 8 chapter 261.

9 SECTION 2. Section 261-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

11 "(a) Except as provided in subsection (c), any person 12 [violating] who violates any provision of this chapter, or any 13 of the rules or orders issued pursuant thereto and relating to: 14

Safety measures, practices, or requirements;

15 Airport security measures or requirements; or (2)16 The licensing and regulation of persons engaged in (3) 17 commercial activities at public airports,
