## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EARLY LEARNING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
- 2 for the executive office on early learning to enter into
- 3 contracts with third-party providers for family-child
- 4 interaction learning programs that support families to take an
- 5 active role in the social, emotional, and cognitive development
- 6 of their young children.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$300,000 or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
- 10 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 11 2018-2019 for the executive office on early learning to enter
- 12 into contracts with third party providers for family-child
- 13 interaction learning programs that support families to take an
- 14 active role in the social, emotional, and cognitive development
- 15 of their young children.

- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the executive
- 2 office on early learning for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
