HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A SUNRISE ANALYSIS OF THE REGULATION OF SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGISTS.

WHEREAS, school psychologists are currently exempt from 1 chapter 465, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), under which the 2 practice of psychology is regulated; and 3 4 WHEREAS, S.B. No. 224 (2017), introduced during the Regular 5 Session of 2017, proposes to regulate the practice of school 6 psychology by establishing licensure requirements for school 7 psychologists; and 8 9 WHEREAS, of twenty-three jurisdictions reviewed, only three 10 jurisdictional boards license school psychologists and the 11 departments of education, boards of education, or other 12 credentialing bodies of the other twenty jurisdictions regulate 13 and license or credential school psychologists; and 14 15 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, HRS, requires certain regulatory 16 measures to be referred to the Auditor for analysis if the 17 regulatory measure being considered for enactment would subject 18 unregulated professions and vocations to licensing or other 19 regulatory controls upon enactment; and 20 21 WHEREAS, section 26H-6, HRS, further requires that referral 22 to the Auditor shall be by concurrent resolution that identifies 23 a specific legislative bill to be analyzed and that the analysis 24 25 shall: 26 Set forth the probably effects of the proposed (1) 27 regulatory measure; 28 29 (2) Assess whether the enactment of the proposed 30 regulatory measure is consistent with the legislative 31

policies of the Hawaii Regulatory Licensing Reform 1 2 Act, chapter 26H, HRS; and 3 4 (3) Assess alternative forms of regulation; 5 6 now, therefore, 7 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 8 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 9 of 2017, the Senate concurring, that in accordance with section 10 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Auditor is requested to 11 conduct a sunrise analysis of S.B. No. 224, S.D. 2, introduced 12 during the Regular Session of 2017, relating to the licensure of 13 school psychologists; and 14 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 16 submit findings and recommendations, including any proposed 17 legislation, to the Legislature not less than twenty days prior 18 to the convening of the Regular Session of 2018; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor. 22 23 24 25 OFFERED BY:
