HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE STATE TO ESTABLISH AFFORDABLE HOUSING PRODUCTION GOALS AND BENCHMARKS TO MEASURE AND EVALUATE AFFORDABLE HOUSING DEVELOPMENT AND CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS.

1 2 3	WHEREAS, the State is currently in a housing crisis that will require an additional fifty-seven thousand affordable housing units by 2025 in order to meet long-term housing
4 5	demands, particularly on Oahu; and
6	WHEREAS, in a report released by the Honolulu Board of
7	Realtors on March 6, 2017, the median price for an existing
8	single-family home reached a near-record high in February 2017,
9	increasing by 7.9 percent over the last year to \$755,000; and
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11	WHEREAS, the supply of available single-family housing in
12	the market is not keeping up with the with the demand for such
13	homes; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, statistics on condominium and townhome sales,
16	which have increased by 11.7 percent over the last year, show that families are opting for affordable alternatives to single-
17	family houses; and
18 19	Tamity houses; and
19 20	WHEREAS, addressing Hawaii's housing problem should be the
20 21	State's number one priority, as it is one of the major reasons
22	why Hawaii residents, especially young families, leave the
23	State; and
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25	WHEREAS, short term fixes alone are no longer enough to
26	address the housing crisis and a long-term plan that includes
27	building more homes for low- to moderate-income households must
28	be developed immediately; and
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WHEREAS, having a long-term goal to work toward and to 1 invite other parties to join in developing affordable housing 2 units that the State desperately needs, will be best achieved by 3 setting housing production goals and benchmarks to measure and 4 evaluate progress; now, therefore, 5 6 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 7 8 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, urges the State to establish a statewide goal to 9 develop fifty-seven thousand affordable housing units for 10 occupancy by December 31, 2025; and 11 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that at least 22,500 units should be 13 rental units that are affordable to low- and moderate-income 14 households pursuant to Act 127, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the remaining 34,500 affordable 17 units may be rental or for-sale units; and 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor of the State of 20 Hawaii and the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu, along 21 with their respective planning and permitting agencies, are 22 urged to work together to establish production benchmarks and 23 significantly increase the issuance of permits for the 24 development of affordable housing within the urban core to 25 achieve this goal; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor of the 29 State of Hawaii, the Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu 30 and their respective planning and permitting agencies. 31 32 33 34 OFFERED BY:
