

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING THE PAPAHANAUMOKUAKEA MARINE NATIONAL MONUMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the legislature finds that President Barack Obama 1 2 issued Presidential Proclamation 9478 on August 26, 2016, expanding the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National Monument to 3 provide critical protections for more than seven thousand marine 4 5 species, including whales and sea turtles listed under the Endangered Species Act and the longest-living marine species in 6 7 the world, black coral, which live longer than four thousand 8 five hundred years; and

10 WHEREAS, as ocean acidification, warming, and other impacts 11 of climate change threaten marine ecosystems, expanding the 12 Monument will improve ocean resilience, help the region's 13 distinct physical and biological resources adapt, and create a 14 natural laboratory that will allow scientists to monitor and 15 explore the impacts of climate change on these fragile 16 ecosystems; and

18 WHEREAS, the expanded Monument area contains resources of 19 great historical and cultural significance, including shipwrecks 20 and downed aircrafts from the Battle of Midway during World War 21 II, a battle that marked a major shift in the progress of the 22 war in favor of the Allies; and 23

24 WHEREAS, the expanded area, including the archipelago and 25 its adjacent waters, is considered a sacred place for the Native 26 Hawaiian community, plays a significant role in Native Hawaiian 27 creation and settlement stories, and is used to practice 28 important activities like traditional long-distance voyaging and 29 wayfinding; and



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WHEREAS, Proclamation 9478 directs federal agencies to work 1 2 together with the State to create a joint management plan by August 25, 2019, to adopt regulations, as appropriate, that 3 4 address any further specific actions necessary for the proper care and management of the Monument; now, therefore, 5 6 7 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 8 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Land and 9 Natural Resources is urged to establish the Papahanaumokuakea 10 Marine National Monument program to be placed within the 11 Department's Division of Aquatic Resources to coordinate and 12 13 fulfill the State's role and responsibilities in co-managing the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National Monument; and 14 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department is designated as the lead agency of the State to co-manage the Monument in 17 accordance with Proclamation 8031 of June 15, 2006, and expanded 18 19 by Proclamation 9478 of August 25, 2016; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department should 22 collaborate with the Office of Hawaiian Affairs in the perpetuation of Hawaiian cultural resources within the Monument, 23 24 including the customary and traditional rights and practices of 25 Native Hawaiians exercised for subsistence, cultural, and religious purposes under section 7 of article XII of the state 26 27 constitution; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the program should issue permits as part of the co-trustee monument permit process; 30 provide advice and recommendations to the governor, the 31 32 Department, and other state departments and agencies on any matter relating to the management of the Monument; and solicit 33 34 and accept grants, donations, and contributions; and 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department should charge 36 fees that are proportional to the nature and complexity of the 37 projects or services performed by the program, such as the 38 39 issuance of permits; and 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 41 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 42





Board of Land and Natural Resources and Chair of the Board of
Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.
