
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO
ESTABLISH THE REMNANT PARCEL TASK FORCE.

1 WHEREAS, the State owns numerous small pieces of property
2 that are commonly referred to as remnant parcels; and
3

4 WHEREAS, it may be to the State's advantage to sell some of
5 these remnant parcels; and
6

7 WHEREAS, creating a comprehensive inventory of public lands
8 that are remnant parcels and establishing a process for
9 evaluating their potential would assist in the disposition of
10 eligible remnant parcels; and
11

12 WHEREAS, establishing a working group attached to the
13 Department of Land and Natural Resources would facilitate the
14 creation of a remnant parcel inventory and a parcel evaluation
15 and disposition process; now, therefore,
16

17 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
18 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session
19 of 2017, the Senate concurring, that the Department of Land and
20 Natural Resources is requested to establish the Remnant Parcel
21 Task Force; and

23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force
24 is requested to include at least the Chairperson of the Board of
25 Land and Natural Resources or the Chairperson's designee, one
26 representative of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs, one member of
27 the Senate Committee on Water and Land, and one member of the
28 House of Representatives Committee on Water and Land; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the Remnant
 2 Parcel Task Force may invite any other persons who they deem
 3 appropriate to be part of the task force; and

 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force
 6 is requested to create an inventory of remnant parcels owned by
 7 the State that are suitable for sale, and to determine a process
 8 for the evaluation and disposition of suitable remnant parcels;

 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Remnant Parcel Task Force
 12 is requested to provide a report of its findings and
 13 recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
 14 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
 15 the 2018 Regular Session; and

 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 18 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the
 19 Board of Land and Natural Resources and the Chief Executive
 20 Officer of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.
