HOUSE RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING THE PAPAHANAUMOKUAKEA MARINE NATIONAL MONUMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the legislature finds that President Barack Obama 1 issued Presidential Proclamation 9478 on August 26, 2016, 2 expanding the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National Monument to 3 4 provide critical protections for more than seven thousand marine species, including whales and sea turtles listed under the 5 Endangered Species Act and the longest-living marine species in 6 the world, black coral, which live longer than four thousand 7 five hundred years; and 8 9

10 WHEREAS, as ocean acidification, warming, and other impacts 11 of climate change threaten marine ecosystems, expanding the 12 Monument will improve ocean resilience, help the region's 13 distinct physical and biological resources adapt, and create a 14 natural laboratory that will allow scientists to monitor and 15 explore the impacts of climate change on these fragile 16 ecosystems; and

18 WHEREAS, the expanded Monument area contains resources of 19 great historical and cultural significance, including shipwrecks 20 and downed aircrafts from the Battle of Midway during World War 21 II, a battle that marked a major shift in the progress of the 22 war in favor of the Allies; and

24 WHEREAS, the expanded area, including the archipelago and 25 its adjacent waters, is considered a sacred place for the Native 26 Hawaiian community, plays a significant role in Native Hawaiian 27 creation and settlement stories, and is used to practice 28 important activities like traditional long-distance voyaging and 29 wayfinding; and

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31 WHEREAS, Proclamation 9478 directs federal agencies to work32 together with the State to create a joint management plan by



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1 August 25, 2019, to adopt regulations, as appropriate, that address any further specific actions necessary for the proper 2 care and management of the Monument; now, therefore, 3 4 5 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 6 7 of 2017, that the Department of Land and Natural Resources is 8 urged to establish the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National 9 Monument program to be placed within the Department's Division of Aquatic Resources to coordinate and fulfill the State's role 10 and responsibilities in co-managing the Papahanaumokuakea Marine 11 12 National Monument; and 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department is designated as 15 the lead agency of the State to co-manage the Monument in accordance with Proclamation 8031 of June 15, 2006, and expanded 16 by Proclamation 9478 of August 25, 2016; and 17 18 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department should 20 collaborate with the Office of Hawaiian Affairs in the perpetuation of Hawaiian cultural resources within the Monument, 21 including the customary and traditional rights and practices of 22 23 Native Hawaiians exercised for subsistence, cultural, and religious purposes under section 7 of article XII of the state 24 constitution; and 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the program should issue 27 permits as part of the co-trustee monument permit process; 28 provide advice and recommendations to the governor, the 29 Department, and other state departments and agencies on any 30 matter relating to the management of the Monument; and solicit 31 and accept grants, donations, and contributions; and 32 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department should charge fees that are proportional to the nature and complexity of the 35 projects or services performed by the program, such as the 36 37 issuance of permits; and 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 39 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 40
