HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING SUPPORT FOR THE GOAL OF EFFECTIVELY MANAGING THIRTY PERCENT OF NEARSHORE WATERS BY 2030.

1 WHEREAS, Presidential Proclamation 9478, issued on August 2 26, 2016, emphasized the need to provide critical protections in 3 the nearshore areas around the Papahanaumokuakea Marine National 4 Monument for more than 7,000 marine species, including whales 5 and sea turtles listed under the Endangered Species Act and the 6 longest-living marine species in the world, black coral, which 7 live longer than 4,500 years; and

9 WHEREAS, as ocean acidification, warming, and other impacts 10 of climate change threaten marine ecosystems, expanding the 11 Monument will improve ocean resilience, help the region's 12 distinct physical and biological resources adapt, and create a 13 natural laboratory that will allow scientists to monitor and 14 explore the impacts of climate change on these fragile 15 ecosystems; and

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WHEREAS, the expanded Monument area, including the archipelago and its adjacent waters, is considered a sacred place for the Native Hawaiian community, plays a significant role in Native Hawaiian creation and settlement stories, and is used to practice important activities like traditional longdistance voyaging and wayfinding; and

24 WHEREAS, to improve the resilience of corals and ensure 25 their continued benefit to the State, local stressors that are 26 within our control need to be effectively managed, including 27 sediment and nutrient runoff from land, invasive species, and 28 illegal and unsustainable fishing; and

30 WHEREAS, the State's commitment to effectively manage 30 31 per cent of Hawaii's nearshore waters by 2030 should be echoed 32 throughout all state and county agencies that manage coastal 33 zones; and



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WHEREAS, the Department of Land and Natural Resources 1 should exercise its stewardship responsibility for managing, 2 3 administering, and exercising control over lands, waters, and 4 natural resources within the State's jurisdiction; now, 5 therefore, 6 7 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 8 of 2017, that this body urges the Department of Land and Natural 9 Resources to support the goal of effectively managing 30 per 10 11 cent of nearshore waters by 2030; and 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 13 Natural Resources is urged to collaborate with the Office of 14 Hawaiian Affairs in the perpetuation of Hawaiian cultural 15 resources within the nearshore waters area, including the 16 customary and traditional rights and practices of Native 17 Hawaiians exercised for subsistence, cultural, and religious 18 purposes under Section 7 of Article XII of the State 19 Constitution; and 20 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, by 2019, the Department of Land and Natural Resources is requested to establish benchmarks 23 for the effective management of 30 per cent of nearshore waters 24 25 by 2030; and 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Land and 27 Natural Resources is requested to report its findings and 28 recommendations, and any proposed legislation, to the 29 30 Legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of each Regular Session of the Legislature; and 31 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 34 Land and Natural Resources and Chair of the Board of Trustees of 35 36 the Office of Hawaiian Affairs.



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
