## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION TO UPGRADE AND MODERNIZE ITS COMMUNICATION SYSTEM.

1 WHEREAS, taxpayers find it difficult to resolve tax issues due to a lack of responsive communication from the Department of 2 3 Taxation; and 4 WHEREAS, the Department of Taxation's telephone queue 5 currently holds only twenty calls, and there are only fifteen 6 7 employees answering these calls; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the number of calls received by the Department of Taxation's taxpayer services line can reach up to hundreds of 10 calls per day; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, during periods of high call volume, taxpayers can be put on hold for extended periods of time or told to call back 14 15 at another time; and 16 WHEREAS, a lack of responsive communication can be 17 especially frustrating for taxpayers facing payment deadlines 18 and the threat of mounting penalties; now, therefore, 19 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 22 of 2017, that the Department of Taxation is requested to upgrade 23 and modernize its communication system; and 24 25 26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, as part of this upgrade, the 27 Department of Taxation is requested to increase its number of 28 call centers, improve its internet chat and electronic mail capabilities, and establish and maintain a better frequently 29 asked questions page on its website; and 30 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Taxation is 32 33 requested to report to the Legislature on the progress of this



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upgrade no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 1 Regular Session of 2018; and 2 3

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 4 5 Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Taxation. 6
