## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY TO CONTINUE TO DOCUMENT VIOLATIONS OF THE PROHIBITION ON SMOKING IN AND AROUND PUBLIC HOUSING.

WHEREAS, the Surgeon General of the United States has 1 declared that there is no safe level of exposure to secondhand 2 smoke and that breathing even small amounts of secondhand smoke 3 4 can be dangerous; and 5 6 WHEREAS, "thirdhand smoke" is generally considered to be 7 the residual nicotine and other chemicals left on a variety of indoor surfaces by tobacco smoke; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, residue from thirdhand smoke builds up on surfaces over time, resists routine cleaning, and cannot be eliminated by 11 12 airing out rooms, opening windows, using fans or air conditioners, or confining smoking to only certain areas of a 13 home; and 14 15 WHEREAS, thirdhand smoke residue is thought to react with 16 common indoor pollutants to create a toxic mix that contains 17 cancer-causing substances, which poses a potential health hazard 18 to nonsmokers who are exposed to it, especially children; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Act 91, Session Laws of Hawaii 2014, enacted a 21 prohibition on smoking in and around public-housing projects, 22 state low-income housing projects, and elder or elderly 23 households in an effort to provide smoke-free environments for 24 families; and 25 26 WHEREAS, violators of the prohibition established by Act 27 28 91, codified as section 356D-6.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, may negatively affect the health of subsequent tenants and guests of 29 public housing projects, state low-income housing projects, and 30 elder or elderly households due to the dangers associated with 31 32 thirdhand smoke; now, therefore,



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BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 1 2 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 3 of 2017, that the Hawaii Public Housing Authority is requested to continue to document violations of the prohibitions in 4 5 section 356D-6.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and 6 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Public Housing 8 Authority is requested to retain this documentation in a 9 resident's record to comply with the rules of the Hawaii Public 10 Housing Authority; and 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 12 Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the Board of 13 14 Directors of the Hawaii Public Housing Authority and the Executive Director of the Hawaii Public Housing Authority. 15
