HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO ESTABLISH A TASK FORCE TO INVESTIGATE AND ADDRESS THE DISPOSAL OF WASTEWATER INTO GROUNDWATER RESOURCES.

1 WHEREAS, in Hawaii, wastewater that is not re-used is 2 either discharged to surface water or to groundwater; and 3 4 WHEREAS, wastewater discharged to groundwater is not 5 required to be treated to levels that comply with state waterquality standards designed to keep water safe for fishing and 6 7 swimming; and 8 WHEREAS, regulations for wastewater discharge to 9 10 groundwater do not require consideration of the potential that 11 the discharge may pollute surface water; and 12 13 WHEREAS, recent studies have shown that wastewater 14 discharged into the ground can and does subsequently affect 15 surface water and thus, these discharges should be managed 16 accordingly; and 17 WHEREAS, waste systems and injection well phase upgrades 18 19 could be examined in areas where injection wells may be currently affecting surface water; and 20 21 22 WHEREAS, current regulation of wastewater discharges from groundwater to surface water may lack technical criteria and the 23 high level of rigor necessary to prevent significant pollution 24 of surface water; now, therefore, 25 26 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 27 28 Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, that the Department of Health is requested to establish 29 a task force to investigate and address the disposal of 30 wastewater into groundwater resources, including the following: 31



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Identify regulatory gaps, mandates, and appropriations (1)1 regarding the development of standards for wastewater 2 3 discharged into groundwater; 4 5 (2) Identify statutory revisions specifically addressing wastewater discharges to groundwater where there is 6 7 the potential to affect surface water; and 8 9 (3) Recommend appropriations for staffing to meet the workload demands imposed by any suggested new 10 statutes, mandates, or regulations; and 11 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health is 14 requested to submit the task force's findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 15 Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of the 16 17 Regular Session of 2018; and 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 19 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and Director of 20 Health. 21 22 23 24 OFFERED BY:

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
