### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 286-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- (2) Any person while driving or operating any road machine, farm tractor, [ex] implement of husbandry, or marine terminal equipment, temporarily operated or moved on a highway; provided that no person under the age of thirteen years shall be permitted to drive or operate any such road machine, farm tractor, [ex] implement of husbandry, or marine terminal equipment, on a highway;
- (3) Any person who is at least eighteen years of age and who has in the person's possession a valid driver's license to drive the categories of motor vehicles listed in section 286-102(b), except section 286-102(b)(4), that is equivalent to a driver's license issued in this State but was issued to the person in another state of the United States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, United States Virgin Islands, American Samoa, Guam, a province of the Dominion of Canada, or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands for

- (4) Any person who has in the person's possession a valid commercial motor vehicle driver's license issued by any state of the United States, Mexico, or a province of the Dominion of Canada that issues licenses in accordance with the minimum federal standards for the issuance of commercial motor vehicle driver's licenses; and
- Any person who drives or operates state or county **10** (5) 11 motor vehicles while employed by, in the service of, **12** or volunteering for the state or county fire 13 departments, provided that they are trained and 14 certified to drive category (4) motor vehicles as set forth in section 286-102(b)(4) by the state or county 15 16 government, as appropriate, and provided that the person maintains a category (3) license as set forth 17 in section 286-102(b)(3)." 18
- 19 SECTION 4. Section 291-36, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 20 amended as follows:
- 21 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

- 1 "(a) The director of transportation, in the case of state
- 2 highways, or the county engineer, in the case of county roads
- 3 and streets, may, upon application in writing, issue a written
- 4 permit authorizing the applicant to operate or move a vehicle or
- 5 combination of vehicles, self-propelled construction or farm
- 6 equipment, marine terminal equipment, or special mobile
- 7 equipment of dimensions or weights, including loads or both,
- 8 which exceed the limits set in sections 291-34 and 291-35."
- 9 2. By amending subsection (c) to read:
- 10 "(c) The application for any such permit shall
- 11 specifically describe the vehicle or combination of vehicles,
- 12 the self-propelled construction or farm equipment, the marine
- 13 terminal equipment, the load to be operated or moved, the
- 14 particular highways over which the permit to operate is
- 15 requested, and whether such permit is requested for a single
- 16 trip or for continuous operation."
- 17 3. By amending subsections (e) and (f) to read:
- 18 "(e) Every such permit shall be carried in the vehicle or
- 19 combination of vehicles [or the], self-propelled construction or
- 20 farm equipment, or marine terminal equipment to which it refers
- 21 and shall be open to inspection of any peace officer or traffic



- 1 officer or employee charged with the care or protection of the
- 2 highways; provided that in the case of annual permits, this
- 3 requirement may be met where a copy of the permit is carried in
- 4 the vehicle, and the original permit is readily available for
- 5 inspection from the operator's offices in the county of
- 6 issuance.
- 7 (f) The owner of any vehicle or combination of vehicles
- 8 [or], self-propelled construction or farm equipment, or marine
- 9 terminal equipment found operating in violation of the terms or
- 10 conditions of any permit or over sections of the highway not
- 11 covered by the permit shall be subject to the penalties provided
- 12 in section 291-37."
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 14 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 15 begun before its effective date.
- 16 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
