### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS TO ADDRESS HOMELESSNESS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the coordinated
- 2 statewide homeless initiative provides important, cost-effective
- 3 homelessness prevention and rapid rehousing services statewide
- 4 and increases coordination through the statewide information and
- 5 referral system on behalf of homeless individuals and those at
- 6 risk of homelessness. In approximately eight months, the
- 7 initiative provided financial assistance to 1,279 households,
- 8 thereby assisting 3,992 adults and children who were homeless or
- 9 at risk of becoming homeless.
- 10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- 11 moneys to continue and improve the coordinated statewide
- 12 homeless initiative to prevent homelessness and rehouse homeless
- 13 people in the State.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,500,000 or so much
- 16 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
- 17 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
