A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the University of
- 2 Hawaii system is working towards eliminating the university's
- 3 deferred maintenance backlog and modernizing facilities and
- 4 campus environments to be safe, sustainable, and supportive of
- 5 modern practices in teaching, learning, and research.
- 6 The legislature further finds that the university has a
- 7 ten-year strategy plan to eliminate deferred maintenance and
- 8 reach modernization goals, which includes implementing projects
- 9 to reduce energy consumption and to generate renewable energy on
- 10 campus.
- 11 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate general funds for
- 12 project-funded staff positions for capital improvement program
- 13 projects.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 16 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and
- 17 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 18 year 2018-2019 for the costs relating to wages and fringe



- 1 benefits for permanent, project-funded staff positions that may
- 2 also include funds for non-permanent positions for the
- 3 implementation of capital improvement projects for the
- 4 University of Hawaii.
- 5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the University
- 6 of Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on May 12, 2059.
