A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Waianae Coast
- 2 Comprehensive Health Center was established in 1972 to provide
- 3 health services for the federally designated medically
- 4 underserved Waianae coast with operational funds granted through
- 5 the Department of Health and Human Services. The legislature
- 6 further finds that consistent with the Waianae Coast
- 7 Comprehensive Health Center's mission, the center currently
- 8 serves 35,000 patients annually; of the patients served, forty-
- 9 five per cent are Native Hawaiian, followed by Asian and other
- 10 Pacific Islanders, at twenty-four per cent. Seventy per cent of
- 11 patients are at one hundred per cent of the federal poverty
- 12 level or below, nine per cent are uninsured, and fifty-nine per
- 13 cent are participants of the State's medicaid program.
- 14 The legislature further finds that the Waianae Coast
- 15 Comprehensive Health Center's emergency room is one of the most
- 16 heavily utilized on Oahu, serving 13,500 patients through a
- 17 total of 24,000 visits in 2015 to 2016. The Waianae Coast

- 1 Comprehensive Health Center emergency medical services provide a
- 2 safety net for the residents of the Waianae coast. Increased
- 3 homelessness, changing economic conditions, and growing
- 4 behavioral health issues continue to increase the demand for
- 5 emergency medical services in the region. The twenty-four-hour
- 6 emergency services provided by the Waianae Coast Comprehensive
- 7 Health Center help address the issue of geographic isolation
- 8 faced by the communities located on the most western point of
- 9 Oahu.
- 10 The legislature further finds that the Waianae Coast
- 11 Comprehensive Health Center's twenty-four-hour emergency medical
- 12 services program is linked to both the state emergency medical
- 13 services system and the state plan for disaster response. The
- 14 facility is one of the two remaining non-hospital based,
- 15 emergency medical facilities that are a part of this essential
- 16 system of emergency response in the State. The facility was
- 17 regularly included in the state department of health budget
- 18 prior to being supported by the community health centers special
- 19 fund.
- The legislature further finds that based on the history and
- 21 investment of the State in the Waianae Coast Comprehensive

- 1 Health Center's emergency services over the years, it is
- 2 recommended that future investment in a long term funding option
- 3 will ensure stability of emergency services for the leeward
- 4 coast community.
- 5 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds as a grant
- 6 to assist the Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center in the
- 7 operation of its twenty-four-hour emergency medical room to
- 8 continue to serve the residents of the Waianae coast and require
- 9 funding for the Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center's
- 10 emergency services to be included in the department of health's
- 11 base budget beginning with the 2018-2019 fiscal year.
- 12 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 13 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,925,000 or so much
- 14 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 as a grant
- 15 pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to the Waianae
- 16 Coast Comprehensive Health Center for operation of its twenty-
- 17 four-hour emergency room.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 19 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 3. Funds necessary for the operation of Waianae
- 21 Coast Comprehensive Health Center's twenty-four-hour emergency

- services shall be included in the department of health's base 1
- budget beginning with the 2018-2019 fiscal year. 2
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017. 3 Medit

Report Title:

Emergency Medical Services; Emergency Room; Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center; Appropriation

Description:

Appropriates funds as a grant to the Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center for operation of its twenty-four-hour emergency room. Requires funds necessary for the operation of Waianae Coast Comprehensive Health Center's twenty-four-hour emergency services to be included in the department of health's base budget beginning with the 2018-2019 fiscal year.
