A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PRESERVING CORAL REEFS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that oxybenzone, a common
- 2 sunscreen ingredient, has detrimental effects on coral reefs.
- 3 The World Conservation Congress of the International Union for
- 4 Conservation of Nature met in September 2016 in Honolulu. The
- 5 Congress disclosed that 2015 research led by a University of
- 6 Hawai'i professor implicated oxybenzone in coral larvae
- 7 deformity, bleaching, and DNA damage that weakens coral systems'
- 8 cpra; adaptability to climate change. The threat is
- 9 particularly acute in Hawaiian ocean waters where coral
- 10 bleaching is occurring at a historic rate never before noted in
- 11 recorded history.
- 12 The legislature further finds that there are reasonable
- 13 alternatives to oxybenzone-based sunscreens that allow beach
- 14 users to enjoy the outdoors without compromising sun protection,
- 15 such as zinc oxide and titanium oxide.
- 16 The findings of the World Conservation Congress of the
- 17 International Union for Conservation of Nature is in line with

- 1 the senate's focus on "Aloha Honua Climate Change and Energy".
- 2 Aloha Honua seeks to protect and preserve Hawai'i's natural
- 3 resources by exploring ways to improve agricultural practices
- 4 and mitigate climate change impacts. Aloha Honua is a
- 5 commitment to supporting the preservation of nature's unique
- 6 geographic features, including coral reefs, coastlines, and
- 7 watersheds. Aloha Honua also encourages the use of innovative
- 8 technologies to combat invasive species, address biosecurity
- 9 risks, conserve the State's water resources and coral reefs,
- 10 address changing sea levels, and protect the State's fragile
- 11 marine ecosystem.
- 12 As such, the purpose of this Act is to protect Hawai'i's
- 13 coral reefs by prohibiting the use of sunscreens and cosmetics
- 14 containing oxybenzone at beaches.
- 15 SECTION 2. Chapter 187A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 17 and to read as follows:
- 18 "S187A- Oxybenzone; sunscreen and cosmetics
- 19 restrictions. No person shall use or apply sunscreen, sunblock,
- 20 or cosmetic containing any oxybenzone while on a beach or in the
- 21 ocean.

- 1 For purposes of this section, "oxybenzone" includes
- 2 benzophenone-3 and 2-hydroxy-4-methoxyphenyl phenylmethanone."
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
