A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HEALTH CARE PRIVACY HARMONIZATION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to identify the
- 2 circumstances in which the State has a compelling interest in
- 3 the use and disclosure of de-identified protected health
- 4 information under the Health Care Privacy Harmonization Act. It
- 5 is not the intent of the legislature to foreclose other
- 6 circumstances in which the State may similarly have a compelling
- 7 interest in the use or disclosure of this information.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 323B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 10 and to read as follows:
- 11 "§323B- Uses and disclosures of de-identified protected
- 12 health information. Uses and disclosures of de-identified
- 13 protected health information shall be subject to the
- 14 requirements under 45 Code of Federal Regulations section
- 15 164.502(d), as may be amended. The State shall have a
- 16 compelling interest in the public and private use of de-
- 17 identified protected health information for the purposes of

1	medical or economic research, patient protection, public safety,
2	and the proper operation of medical and health care facilities."
3	SECTION 3. Section 323B-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted
5	and to read as follows:
6	"De-identified protected health information" has the same
7	meaning as in 45 Code of Federal Regulations section 164.514(a),
8	as may be amended."
9	SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
