A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§141- Reimbursement transportation cost payment 5 program. (a) There is established within the department of 6 agriculture a reimbursement transportation cost payment program 7 to reimburse eligible producers for a portion of the cost to 8 transport eligible commodities or inputs used to produce an 9 eligible commodity. 10 (b) To be eliqible to receive reimbursement payments under 11 the program, eligible producers shall: 12 (1) Submit an application to the department during a 13 specified period to be determined by the department 14 for each fiscal year; (2) Provide proof of the amount of costs incurred for the 15 16 transportation of the eligible commodity or input,

1		pursuant to subsection (d), in a form to be determined		
2		by the department;		
3	(3)	Comply with all conservation and wetland protection		
4		requirements on all their land;		
5	(4)	Have an average non-agriculture related income of		
6		\$900,000 or less; and		
7	(5)	Be a resident.		
8	(c)	Reimbursement of transportation cost payments under		
9	the program shall be calculated based on the amount of costs			
10	incurred by an eligible producer for transportation of an			
11	eligible commodity or input used to produce an eligible			
12	commodity	commodity during a fiscal year and multiplied by the applicable		
13	percentage of cost-of-living allowance for the applicable fiscal			
14	year.			
15	(d) Eligible producers shall submit their costs for			
16	transportation for calculating reimbursement payments pursuant			
17	to subsection (c) based on one of the following:			
18	(1)	The actual transportation costs incurred by the		
19		eligible producer as demonstrated by verifiable		
20		records; provided that no other type of transportation		

1		rate provided under this subsection shall be permitted
2		for the same reimbursement request;
3	(2)	A fixed rate as established by the department which
4		reflects transportation rates applicable to certain
5		eligible commodities or inputs used to produce the
6		eligible commodity; or
7	(3)	A set rate established by the department which
8		reflects a per cent of the total cost used to
9		represent the transportation cost incurred; provided
10		that this rate will only be used if the inputs do not
11		have an established fixed rate or if a breakdown of
12		the transportation costs is not available.
13	<u>(e)</u>	Reimbursements shall be disbursed upon approval by the
14	department	t to each eligible producer based on an amount
15	calculated	d pursuant to subsection (c).
16	(f)	The department shall begin accepting applications
17	beginning	on July 1, 2019.
18	<u>(g)</u>	For purposes of this section:
19	"Depa	artment" means the department of agriculture.
20	<u>"Elig</u>	gible commodity" shall consist of any of the following:
21	(1)	Aquaculture;

1	<u>(2)</u> <u>Feed;</u>			
2	(3) Fiber;			
3	(4) Floriculture;			
4	(5) Horticulture, including trees;			
5	(6) Insects or products thereof; and			
6	(7) Livestock, including elk, reindeer, bison, horses, and			
7	deer.			
8	"Eligible producers" means farmers and ranchers from all			
9	islands of the State, except Oahu, who ship their goods to Oahu			
10	or farmers and ranchers from any island of the State who export			
11	their eligible commodities out of the State; provided that			
12	commercial fisherman shall not be eligible producers."			
13	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general			
14	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so			
15	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and			
16	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal			
17	year 2018-2019 for the department of agriculture to issue			
18	reimbursements under the reimbursement transportation cost			
19	program.			
20	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department			
21	of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
