11	property in the State. No person less than [eighteen] <u>twenty-</u>					
12	five years of age shall drive a moped or ride as a passenger on					
13	a moped unless the person wears a safety helmet securely					
14	fastened with a chin strap. The safety helmet shall meet the					
15	specifications and requirements established by rules adopted by					
16	the director."					
17	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed					
18	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.					
19	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
