A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE USE OF INTOXICANTS WHILE OPERATING A VEHICLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291E-61, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) A person commits the offense of operating a vehicle
- 4 under the influence of an intoxicant if the person operates or
- 5 assumes actual physical control of a vehicle:
- 6 (1) While under the influence of alcohol in an amount
- 7 sufficient to impair the person's normal mental
- 8 faculties or ability to care for the person and guard
- 9 against casualty;
- 10 (2) While under the influence of any drug that impairs the
- 11 person's ability to operate the vehicle in a careful
- and prudent manner; provided that in the case of
- marijuana, the person's blood shall contain a
- 14 concentration level of five nanograms or more per
- milliliter of active tetrahydrocannabinol, as defined
- in section 329-14(g)(1);

13		(A) While under the influence of alcohol in an amount
14		sufficient to impair the person's normal mental
15		faculties or ability to care for the person and
16		guard against casualty;
17		(B) While under the influence of any drug that
18		impairs the person's ability to operate the
19		vehicle in a careful and prudent manner; provided
20		that in the case of marijuana, the person's blood
21		shall contain a concentration level of five

4	(C)	With .08 or more grams of alcohol per two hundred
5		ten liters of breath; or

7		milliliters or cubic centimeters of blood."

9	matured, penal	ties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
10	begun before it	ts effective date.
