

1 lieutenant governor; provided further that the votes cast in the
2 general election for the nominee for governor shall be deemed
3 cast for the nominee for lieutenant governor [ef] from the same
4 political party. No person shall be elected to the office of
5 lieutenant governor for more than two consecutive full terms.
6 The lieutenant governor shall perform such duties as may be
7 provided by law."

8 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
9 be as follows:

10 "Shall the nominee for lieutenant governor be appointed by
11 the gubernatorial nominee, following the primary election,
12 for the same term and from the same political party as the
13 gubernatorial nominee, rather than be elected in a separate
14 election?"

15 SECTION 4. Constitutional material to be repealed is
16 bracketed and stricken. New constitutional material is
17 underscored.
