BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 456-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "[+]\$456-20[+] Failure to verify identity and signature.
- 4 (a) A person commits the offense of failure to verify identity
- 5 and signature if the person is a commissioned notary public and
- 6 knowingly notarizes a document and:
- 7 (1) If a witness to the signing of the instrument, fails to verify the identity of the signer by personally
- 9 knowing the signer or by comparing the personal
- 10 appearance of the signer with satisfactory proof of
- 11 the signer's identity; or
- 12 (2) If not a witness to the signing of the instrument,
- fails to verify the identity of the signer by
- 14 personally knowing the signer or by comparing the
- personal appearance of the signer with satisfactory
- proof of the signer's identity; or fails to verify the
- signature of the signer by recognizing the signature
