RELATING TO HIGHWAY SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291E-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows: 3 "(c) Any person convicted of violating this section shall 4 be sentenced as follows without possibility of probation or 5 suspension of sentence: (1) For a first offense, or any offense not preceded 6 within a five-year period by conviction for an offense 7 8 under this section, section 291E-66, or section 291-4.5 as that section was in effect on December 31, 10 2001: 11 (A) A term of imprisonment of not less than three 12 consecutive days but not more than thirty days; 13 (B) A fine of not less than [\$250] \$750 but not more than [\$1,000;] \$3,000; 14 15 (C) Revocation of license and privilege to operate a vehicle for an additional year; and 16

15	(3)	For an offense that occurs within five years of two or
16		more prior convictions for offenses under this

20		(A) One year imprisonment;
21		(B) A [\$2,000] \$6,000 fine;

6	SECTION 2	. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7	matured, penal	ties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8	begun before i	ts effective date.
