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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRIMINAL PROSECUTION UNDER CAMPAIGN FINANCE LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 11-412, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Any person who knowingly or intentionally falsifies
- 4 any report required by this part with the intent to circumvent
- 5 the law or deceive the commission or who violates section 11-352
- 6 or 11-353 shall be guilty of a class C felony. A person charged
- 7 with a class C felony shall not be eligible for a deferred
- 8 acceptance of quilty plea or nolo contendere plea under chapter
- 9 853. The applicable period of limitation for a prosecution
- 10 under this subsection shall not commence until the discovery of
- 11 the offense by the commission."
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 701-108, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (2) to read as follows:
- "(2) Except as otherwise provided [in this section,] by
- 15 law, prosecutions for other offenses are subject to the
- 16 following periods of limitation:



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1	(a)	A prosecution for manslaughter where the death was not
2		caused by the operation of a motor vehicle must be
3		commenced within ten years after it is committed;
4	(b)	A prosecution for a class A felony must be commenced
5		within six years after it is committed;
6	(c)	A prosecution for any felony under part IX of chapter
7		708 must be commenced within five years after it is
8		committed;
9	(d)	A prosecution for any other felony must be commenced
10		within three years after it is committed; provided
11		that the period of limitation for a prosecution under
12		section 11-412 shall commence pursuant to that
13		section;
14	(e)	A prosecution for a misdemeanor or parking violation
15		must be commenced within two years after it is
16		committed; and
17	(f)	A prosecution for a petty misdemeanor or a violation
18		other than a parking violation must be commenced
19		within one year after it is committed."

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1	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3	begun before its effective date.
4	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
