A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
- 2 to the department of health for the purchase of ambulance
- 3 vehicles and the operational costs, including equipment,
- 4 supplies, and personnel costs for state-certified emergency
- 5 medical services personnel, for two twenty-four-hour, seven-
- 6 days-a-week, ambulance units, to be allocated as follows:
- 7 (1) One unit for the county of Kauai; and
- 8 (2) One unit for the county of Hawaii.
- 9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for two
- 12 twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week, ambulance units, including
- 13 the purchase of one ambulance vehicle for each unit and
- 14 operating costs, including equipment, supplies, and personnel
- 15 costs for state-certified emergency medical services personnel,
- 16 to be allocated as follows:
- 17 (1) One unit for the county of Kauai; and

- 1 (2) One unit for the county of Hawaii.
- 2 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 3 health for the purposes of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
