A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
- 2 to the department of health for the purchase of an ambulance
- 3 vehicle and the operational costs for one ambulance unit.
- 4 Operational costs include equipment, supplies, and personnel
- 5 costs for state-certified emergency medical services personnel.
- 6 This ambulance unit is to be a twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-
- 7 week service for the county of Kauai.
- 8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 10 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for the
- 11 purchase of an ambulance vehicle and the operational costs,
- 12 including equipment, supplies, and personnel costs for state-
- 13 certified emergency medical services personnel, for a twenty-
- 14 four-hour, seven-days-a-week, ambulance unit for the county of
- 15 Kauai.
- 16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 17 health for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
