### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TORT LIABILITY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The liability protections afforded to
- 2 lifeguards in section 663-1.52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, enacted
- 3 by Act 170, Session Laws of Hawaii 2002, (Act 170) is scheduled
- 4 to sunset on June 30, 2017, in accordance with Act 98, Session
- 5 Laws of Hawaii 2014.
- 6 The legislature finds that Act 170 provides limited
- 7 liability protection for county lifeguards and counties
- 8 providing lifeguard services on beaches or in the ocean, except
- 9 in the case of gross negligence or wanton acts or omissions.
- 10 This limited liability protection was made necessary because
- 11 some counties would not otherwise provide lifequard services at
- 12 state beach parks, due to the fear of potential liability. The
- 13 legislature finds that Act 170 created a climate in which
- 14 lifeguard services can be provided by the counties without fear
- 15 of liability and, therefore, is a life-saving measure that
- 16 should be made permanent.

- 2 protections afforded by Act 170 permanent.
- 3 SECTION 2. Act 170, Session Laws of Hawaii 2002, as
- 4 amended by section 4 of Act 152, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, as
- 5 amended by section 2 of Act 81, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, as
- 6 amended by section 1 of Act 98, Session Laws of Hawaii 2014, is
- 7 amended by amending section 5 to read as follows:
- 8 "SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval[+
- 9 provided that section 1 of this Act shall be repealed on
- 10 June 30, 2017]."
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken.
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2017.
