A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that responding quickly
- 2 to newly detected invasive species in the State can often "nip
- 3 the problem in the bud" and prevent the invasive species from
- 4 becoming firmly established, thus saving taxpayers money in the
- 5 long term. State agencies currently lack resources and a
- 6 mechanism to quickly respond to new threats and, therefore, may
- 7 be missing opportunities to eliminate those threats. This may
- 8 allow new invasive species to become established in the State
- 9 and make efforts to mitigate or eliminate them more protracted
- 10 and expensive.
- 11 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to create a
- 12 mechanism for the rapid response to invasive species so that
- 13 newly detected threats may be immediately addressed.
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 194, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 16 and to read as follows:
- 17 "\$194- Invasive species rapid response special fund.
- 18 (a) There is established the invasive species rapid response



- 1 special fund, into which shall be deposited appropriations by
- 2 the legislature for the purposes of mitigating or eradicating
- 3 newly detected invasive species threats in the State. All
- 4 interest earned or accrued on moneys deposited into the fund
- 5 shall become part of the fund. The council shall administer the
- 6 special fund and may expend moneys in the special fund in
- 7 accordance with this section.
- 8 (b) If the council determines that one or more newly
- 9 detected invasive species pose a substantial threat to the
- 10 agriculture, commerce, economy, environment, or public health of
- 11 the State or otherwise warrant immediate action, the council
- 12 shall submit a request to the governor to declare that there
- 13 exists an invasive species emergency.
- 14 (c) Upon declaration by the governor pursuant to
- 15 subsection (b) that there exists an invasive species emergency,
- 16 the council may take action in response to the emergency and
- 17 make expenditures from the fund without legislative approval and
- 18 without regard to chapters 36, 37, and 89.
- 19 (d) The council shall make an accounting of moneys
- 20 expended from the fund and shall include that information in its
- 21 annual report to the legislature."

1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and 4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 5 year 2018-2019 for deposit into the invasive species rapid 6 response special fund. 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 8 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act. 9 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017. 11
