A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD CARE FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 346-153, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$346-153 Records of deficiencies and complaints; release
- 4 to public[-]; report to legislature. (a) For every child care
- 5 facility, the department shall maintain records for the current
- 6 and previous two years of: results of its inspections;
- 7 notifications to providers of deficiencies; corrective action
- 8 taken; complaints of violations of rules adopted under this
- 9 part; results of its investigations; resolution of complaints;
- 10 and suspensions, revocations, reinstatements, restorations, and
- 11 reissuances of licenses, temporary permits, and registrations
- 12 issued under this part. Notwithstanding any other law to the
- 13 contrary, the records described in this section shall be
- 14 available for inspection in the manner set forth in chapter 92F
- 15 and [may] shall be posted by the department on a public website;
- 16 provided that with respect to records of family child care homes
- 17 and group child care homes, sensitive personal information,

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1	including home addresses, or information provided to the
2	department with the understanding that it would not be publicly
3	divulged shall be deleted or obliterated prior to making the
4	records available to the public. Nothing in this section shall
5	authorize the department to release the names of or any other
6	identifying information on complainants. The department may
7	withhold information on a complaint for which an investigation
8	is being conducted for not more than ten working days following
9	the date of filing of the complaint; provided that if an
10	investigation relates to an alleged criminal offense, no
11	information shall be released until the investigation has been
12	completed and the director has determined that no legal
13	proceeding will be jeopardized by its release.
14	(b) The department shall submit a report to the
15	legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
16	each regular session that includes the following information
17	from the records maintained pursuant to subsection (a):
18	(1) Complaints of violations of rules adopted pursuant to
19	this part and actions the department took to address
20	the complaints;

(2) Results of investigations; and

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- 1 (3) License revocations."

- 3 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
