A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 465D-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 3 This chapter is not intended to restrict the practice 4 of other licensed or credentialed practitioners practicing 5 within their own recognized scopes of practice and shall not 6 apply to: 7 (1) An individual working within the scope of practice or 8 duties of another licensed profession that overlaps 9 with the practice of behavior analysis; provided that 10 the person does not purport to be a behavior analyst; 11 (2) An individual who implements or designs applied 12 behavior analysis services and possesses a board 13 certification [as an assistant behavior analyst by the 14 Behavior Analyst Certification Board and accredited 15 by a nationally recognized accrediting body who 16 practices in accordance with the most recent 17 supervisory and ethical requirements adopted by [the
