## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that according to the
- 2 Hawaii tourism authority, visitors to the State spend in excess
- 3 of \$1,200,000,000 per month. The aviation industry is important
- 4 for inter-island travel for tourism, medical needs, and inter-
- 5 island commerce. The State's economy is highly dependent on
- 6 tourism and the ability to travel between islands. There is a
- 7 proliferation of helicopter use in the State for travel,
- 8 recreational, and medical needs. However, only traditional
- 9 aircrafts are afforded certain tax exemptions. Due to changes
- 10 in the industry and travel options, taxes levied on aviation
- 11 businesses need to be updated to promote inter-island travel
- 12 options for visitors and residents, and the interests of the
- 13 State.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to create equity among the types
- 15 of available aircrafts by exempting helicopter service and
- 16 maintenance and construction of related facilities from the
- 17 general excise tax.



- SECTION 2. Section 237-24.9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "aircraft" in subsection 3 (b) to read as follows: ""Aircraft" means a helicopter, or any craft or artificial 4 5 contrivance of whatever description engaged in intrastate, 6 interstate, or international scheduled commercial use as defined
- 7 in chapter 263, that operates with two or more jet engines."
- 8 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
