BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 321-30.1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 3 "(c) The department, upon completion of the transfer of
- 4 the medical use of marijuana program, shall charge a medical
- 5 marijuana registration fee to qualifying patients of no more
- 6 than \$35[-]; provided that the department shall not charge a fee
- 7 to a qualifying patient who is a veteran of the United States
- 8 military."
- 9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
