A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 92-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$92-28 State service fees; increase or decrease of. Any
- 4 law to the contrary notwithstanding, the fees or other nontax

- revenues shall be subject to the approval of the
