## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AUTHORITY TO ADJUST PROFESSIONAL AND VOCATIONAL LICENSING FEES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 92-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§92-28 State service fees; increase or decrease of. Any

law to the contrary notwithstanding, the fees or other nontax

5 revenues assessed or charged by any board, commission, or other

5		meeting held during or prior to the semester preceding

8		be set by any chapter cited in this section;
9	(5)	The authority to increase or decrease fees or nontax
10		revenues pursuant to this section shall be exempt from

14		notices of proposed rulemaking actions under chapter
15		91 shall not exceed 10 cents a page, as required by
16		section 91-2.5."
