SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A RARE DISEASE TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, a rare disease is defined as a disease that 1 affects fewer than two hundred thousand people in the United 2 3 States; and 4 5 WHEREAS, there are seven thousand different known rare diseases affecting approximately thirty million men, women, and 6 7 children in the United States; and 8 WHEREAS, out of a population of 1,431,000 persons in the 9 State of Hawaii, more than 143,000 persons are affected by a 10 rare disease, with more than half of these rare diseases being 11 specific to the Pacific region; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the exact cause of many rare diseases remains 14 unknown; eighty percent of rare diseases are genetic in origin 15 and can be linked to a mutation in a single gene or in multiple 16 17 genes, and these genetic diseases may be passed from generation to generation; and 18 19 WHEREAS, it is sound public policy to encourage and fund 20 research in the development of new treatments for rare diseases; 21 22 now, therefore, 23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth 24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, the 25 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 26 Health is urged to establish a Rare Disease Task Force comprised 27 of at least one representative from the Department of Health, 28 persons living with rare diseases, and other interested 29 30 stakeholders from the community to investigate and make recommendations on issues relating to guality, cost 31 effectiveness, and accessibility of treatments and services to 32 persons with rare diseases in the State; and 33 34
