SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO COORDINATE WITH VARIOUS STATE
AGENCIES TO CREATE A PLAN TO NAME A SCHOOL, BUILDING, ROAD,
PARK, OR OTHER PROPERTY UNDER STATE CONTROL AFTER PRESIDENT
BARACK H. OBAMA.

1 WHEREAS, Barack Hussein Obama was born to Barack Obama, Sr.
2 and Ann Dunham on August 4, 1961, in Honolulu, Hawaii; and
3

4 WHEREAS, Barack Obama spent his formative years attending
5 high school at Punahou School on the island of Oahu; and
6

7 WHEREAS, Barack Obama began working on the south side of
8 Chicago as a community organizer for low-income residents in the
9 Roseland and the Altgeld Gardens communities; and
10

11 WHEREAS, in 1991, Barack Obama graduated magna cum laude
12 from Harvard Law School; and
13

14 WHEREAS, after being elected to the Illinois Senate in
15 1996, Barack Obama drafted legislation on ethics and worked to
16 expand health care services and early childhood education
17 programs for low-income families; and
18

19 WHEREAS, in 2005, Barack Obama was sworn in as a United
20 States senator representing Illinois, and was only the third
21 African American to hold a United States Senate seat since
22 Reconstruction; and

24 WHEREAS, on January 20, 2009, Barack Obama was sworn in as
25 the forty-fourth president of the United States of America; and

27 WHEREAS, under President Obama's leadership, the United
28 States economy thrived, the national deficit shrank by two-
29 thirds, and the national unemployment rate dropped below 5.3
30 percent; and

1 WHEREAS, under the leadership of President Obama, the
2 landmark Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act was passed,
3 allowing more than sixteen million Americans to have affordable
4 and quality health care; and

6 WHEREAS, additional accomplishments of President Obama
7 include ending United States combat operations in Iraq, winning
8 the Nobel Peace Prize, signing into law the Dodd-Frank Wall
9 Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, and beginning the
10 process of normalizing relations with Cuba; and

12 WHEREAS, President Obama is one of numerous individuals of
13 African American heritage who have played integral roles in the
14 history of Hawaii, including Anthony D. Allen, Betsey Stockton,
15 Thomas McCants Stewart, Alice Ball, Helene Hale, and William F.
16 Crockett; and

18 WHEREAS, President Obama's legacy includes not just his
19 historic role as the first African American United States
20 president, but also his tireless dedication as a progressive and
21 forward thinking leader; now, therefore,

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth
24 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, the
25 House of Representatives concurring, that the Governor is
26 requested to coordinate with various state agencies including
27 but not limited to the Department of Transportation, University
28 of Hawaii System, Department of Education, and Department of
29 Accounting and General Services to create a plan to name a
30 school, building, road, park, or other property under the
31 control of the State in honor of President Barack Obama; and

33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to
34 submit a joint report of the status of the plan to the
35 Legislature no later than twenty days before the convening of
36 the Regular Session of 2018; and

38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Foundation on Culture
39 and the Arts is requested to commission a statue of President
40 Barack Obama to be located on state or federal property; and
