SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO IDENTIFY ECONOMIC, ENVIRONMENTAL, AND REGULATORY CONSEQUENCES OF CROP DEGRADATION CAUSED BY INVASIVE AND ENDANGERED SPECIES IN HAWAII.

WHEREAS, invasive and endangered species have negative impacts on Hawaii crop and animal production, including declining yields and depressed returns from the cultivation of agricultural products; and

WHEREAS, invasive and endangered species are affecting farmers statewide, and negative impacts are particularly acute where the invasive and endangered species are relatively recently introduced and traditional methods for control have not been established; and

WHEREAS, invasive and endangered species directly affect the growing of crops for local consumption and directly impact Hawaii farmers' ability to supply fresh local crops to people in the State; and

WHEREAS, while farmers and ranchers have experienced the negative impacts of invasive and endangered species, they don't necessarily have the training to document the economic and agricultural harm being caused by these damaging pests; and

WHEREAS, identifying the impacts of invasive and endangered species on Hawaii agriculture is necessary to facilitate a unified federal, state, and county effort to address this agricultural threat; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2017, that the Department of Agriculture and Department of Land and Natural Resources are requested to identify economic, environmental, and regulatory consequences of crop degradation caused by invasive and endangered species in Hawaii; and 1 2
