Your Committee has reviewed the personal history, resume, and statement submitted by the nominee and finds Tivoli Faaumu to possess the requisite qualifications to be nominated to the Board of Private Detectives and Guards.

Your Committee received testimony in support of the nomination of Tivoli Faaumu from the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs and three individuals.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that Police Chief Faaumu's background and extensive experience qualify him to be nominated for appointment to the Board of Private Detectives and Guards as a chief of police member. Your Committee notes that Police Chief Faaumu has been with the Maui Police Department for over thirty years, is the Department's current Chief of Police, and is an active, dedicated, and well-respected member of the State's law enforcement community.
