"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT,"

The purpose of this measure is to stimulate and diversify Hawaii's economy by establishing and funding the High-growth Grant Program and Special Fund to provide grants to qualified businesses to expand business operations, improve business productivity, and invest in food safety or quality control programs.

Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism, The High Technology Development Corporation, The Chamber of Commerce Hawaii, Maui Chamber of Commerce, Envisions Entertainment, Maui Brewing Company, Hawaii Food Industry Association, Kauai Island Brewing Company, and International Longshore and Warehouse Union Local 142 testified in support of this measure. (1) Changing its effective date to July 1, 2038, to facilitate further discussion; and
