Your Committee on Finance, to which was referred H.B. No. 632  
entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO WATER INFRASTRUCTURE LOANS,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to broaden the Hawaii Water  
Infrastructure Loan Program to:

- (1) Amend the definition of "water infrastructure charge" to  
include on-bill charges for loan repayments and other  
charges that may be imposed on the water utility; and
- (2) Include water utilities and water tanks in the Hawaii  
Water Infrastructure Loan Program.

The Department of Agriculture, Board of Water Supply of the  
City and County of Honolulu, Hawaii Farm Bureau, and Ulupono  
Initiative supported this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:


- (1) Amending the effective date to July 1, 2030, to  
facilitate further discussion; and



- (2) Making technical, nonsubstantive amendments for consistency, clarity, and style.
