Your Committees on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs and Labor & Public Employment, to which was referred H.B. No. 865 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to make employees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs subject to civil service and collective bargaining, and to give the Office of Hawaiian Affairs voting rights as a public employer.

The Hawaiian Government Employees Association, AFSCME Local 152, AFL-CIO, Koʻolaupoko Hawaiian Civic Club, Hoʻomana Pono, LLC., and two individuals testified in support of this measure. The Department of Budget and Finance, Office of Hawaiian Affairs, and one individual testified in opposition to this measure. The Office of Collective Bargaining provided comments.

Your Committees have amended this measure by:

- Clarifying that the Board of Trustees of the Office of Hawaiian Affairs has a single vote, rather than each trustee having one vote;
- (2) Specifying that the governor shall have seven votes for the purpose of negotiating a collective bargaining agreement, rather than six votes; and

(3) Making technical nonsubstantive amendments for clarity, consistency, and style.
