Your Committee on Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian
Affairs, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 198 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF
HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS TO CONVENE STAKEHOLDERS OF NATIVE HAWAIIAN-
CULTURE-BASED HOOPONOPONO SERVICES,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to request the Office of
Hawaiian Affairs to:

- (1) Convene stakeholders on capacity building, training, and the perpetuation of Ho'oponopono to strengthen integrative public safety programs that can incorporate Native Hawaiian values, practices, families, and communities into public safety and other appropriate state government programming;
- (2) Develop models that support Ho'oponopono as a traditional Native Hawaiian system of well-being and improve state prevention, intervention, or reintegration programs targeting Native Hawaiians; and
- (3) Submit its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than 20 days before the convening of the Regular Session of 2018.
