Your Committee on Water and Land, to which was referred H.C.R. No. 27 entitled:

"HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TERM, NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENT COVERING PORTION OF STATE SUBMERGED LANDS AT WAIMANALO, KOOLAUPOKO, OAHU, FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF THE EXISTING PIER, AND FOR USE, REPAIR, AND MAINTENANCE OF THE EXISTING IMPROVEMENTS CONSTRUCTED THEREON,"

begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to authorize the issuance of a term, non-exclusive easement for a portion of state submerged lands identified as tax map key: (1) 4-1- 001:seaward of 011, Waimanalo, Koolaupoko, Oahu, for the maintenance and repair of an existing pier, and for use, repair, and maintenance of the existing improvements constructed thereon, pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

Your Committee received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Land and Natural Resources.

Your Committee finds that, pursuant to section 171-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the Board of Land and Natural Resources may lease submerged lands with the prior approval of the Governor and the prior authorization of the Legislature by concurrent resolution. Your Committee further finds that on January 13,

2017, under agenda item D-14, the Board of Land and Natural Resources approved a grant of a fifty-five-year non-exclusive easement to resolve the encroachment of the pier identified in this measure, subject to the easement grantee paying the State the fair market value of the easement as determined by an independent appraisal. Your Committee concludes that the easement is necessary for the maintenance and repair of the existing pier and for use, repair, and maintenance of the existing improvements constructed thereon.

Your Committee has amended this measure by:

- (1) Clarifying that Mr. Muller was acting as trustee of the C. Michael Muller Trust when he expressed an interest in converting the revocable permit to a long-term easement; and
- (2) Making a technical, nonsubstantive amendment to the title for the purposes of clarity and consistency.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Water and Land that is attached to this report, your Committee concurs with the intent and purpose of H.C.R. No. 27, as amended herein, and recommends that it be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means, in the form attached hereto as H.C.R. No. 27, S.D. 1.
