Your Committees on Human Services and Commerce, Consumer Protection, and Health, to which was referred S.B. No. 397 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE HOSPITAL SUSTAINABILITY PROGRAM,"

beg leave to report as follows:

The purpose and intent of this measure is to:

- (1) Continue the hospital sustainability program for two years; and
- (2) Appropriate funds out of the hospital sustainability program special fund for fiscal years 2017-2018 and 2018-2019.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the Department of Human Services, Hawaii Health Systems Corporation, East Hawaii Region of the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation, The Queen's Health Systems, Healthcare Association of Hawaii, Chamber of Commerce Hawaii, Hawaii Pacific Health, and one individual.

Your Committees find that the Legislature created the hospital sustainability program which was enacted by Act 217, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, to increase Medicaid payments to hospitals in recognition that Medicaid payments to hospitals were below the actual costs of care. Because of the hospital sustainability program, Medicaid payments to many facilities in

the State are closer to the actual costs of care, which helps to ensure that Medicaid patients have access to the hospital care they need.

No. 397 and recommend that it pass Second Reading and be referred to your Committee on Ways and Means.
