The purpose and intent of this measure is to appropriate funds to the State Foundation on Culture and the Arts to establish an arts in the military program.

Your Committees received testimony in support of this measure from the State of Hawaii Department of Defense, State Foundation on Culture and the Arts, and one individual.

Your Committees find that the State's large military community would benefit greatly from programing and partnerships with arts organizations. Your Committees further find that afterschool arts programs, healing arts programs, performances on military bases, and participation in visual arts programing would make a significant contribution to the quality of life of the State's military community. Your Committees note that the recommended appropriation to establish the arts in the military program is \$200,000.
