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<u>SB 1091</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO BIOSECURITY. Appropriate moneys to DOA to enhance the biosecurity program by funding invasive incipient species management programs.	AEN, WAM
<u>SB 1239</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO RAPID OHIA DEATH. Appropriates funds for research on prevention and mitigation of Rapid Ohia Death.	AEN, WAM
<u>SB 1193</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Establishes an income tax credit for producers who sell agricultural commodities directly to consumers.	AEN, WAM
<u>SB 1194</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Exempts agricultural commodities produced in the State and sold directly to consumers from the general excise tax up to a limit of \$50,000 per year in gross income.	AEN, WAM

<u>SB 1288</u> Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR HPC FOODS, LTD. Authorizes the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds to assist HPC Foods, Ltd., to fund multi-project capital improvement programs and the construction of facilities.	AEN, WAM
