Expands the law on planned community associations to apply to

homeowners' associations.

HB 193 Status RELATING TO PROPERTY.

CPC, FIN

Increases the amount of the exemption from attachment or execution of (1) real property that is owned by any individual who is not delinquent on income taxes, real property taxes, or mortgages; and (2) a motor vehicle. Exempts one month of child support and spousal support from

attachment or execution.
