HB 1577, HD1 RELATING TO COMPOSTING.

(HSCR219) Authorizes the Department of Agriculture to issue grants to Status establish a composting grant pilot project in DOE schools. Establishes a composting grant pilot project working group. Requires report to legislature. Appropriates funds. (HB1577 HD1)
