**SB 1249** RELATING TO TECHNOLOGY INNOVATION. ETT, WAM

Establishes the Technology Innovation Corporation, a nonprofit Status & corporation attached to the High Technology Development Testimony

Corporation, to assist in attracting high technology development

opportunities to the State. Appropriates funds.

**SB 1306** RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS. ETT, WAM

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM. Status &

Establishes an office of public-private partnership within the **Testimony** department of business, economic development, and tourism.

Requires that the office create a strategic plan; create

collaboration amongst state agencies to identify and implement public-private projects; and oversee and implement the public-

private projects. Makes an appropriation.

**SB 760** RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS. ETT, CPH/WAM

Codifies exemptions to permitting requirements established by Status & Act 151, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, within the Hawaii **Testimony** Revised Statutes and expands those exemptions to include

broadband over wireless or mobile platforms, including small

wireless facilities. Establishes a definition of wireless

communications antennas that include small wireless facilities. Repeals those sections of Act 151, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011, which have been codified within the Hawaii Revised

Statutes.
